Although, it was well below our goal, we were thrilled to once again offer our support to children in need in our community. Once more, we also included masks in all of the children's bags.

Our shoppers once again went out and did an amazing job, our bag checkers worked in teams, in different time slots in order to maintain social distancing, and our delivery teams got the final bags to the children in our community safely.

We were also able to work around the winter closures for schools and donated about 350 pair of winter gloves to our schools to have on hand for children who needed them. Our board members handled this endeavour with shopping and delivery. Amazing team! We have decided to add onto our program and reached out for volunteer knitters to donate hats to go along with our glove program and have had overwhelming response, so we look forward to that in 2022.

Once again we are so grateful to the community in which we live. The support we receive from our donors and volunteers keeps us motivated to continue and grow our program in the years to come.




